SWIMMING POOL RULES

- 1. Everyone must obey the lifeguards.
- 2. No profanity allowed.
- 3. No one will be permitted in the pool unless they are wearing an association pool (ID) tag.
- 4. Children under the age of 14 will not be permitted in the pool unless accompanied by a person 18 years of age or older.
- 5. There will be a 10 minute rest period at 10 minutes to the hour. All swimmers under 18 years of age will not be allowed in the pool during this time (that means they must get out of the water completely.) Only adults can swim.
- 6. A responsible adult guardian must supervise his/her own children in the baby pool.
- 7. No one over the age of 6 is allowed in the wading pool.
- 8. No horseplay or running allowed.
- 9. No pushing, dunking, or general roughhousing allowed in the pool water, deck area, or restrooms.
- 10. No hard objects such as footballs, Frisbees, and tennis balls are to be allowed in the pool area.
- 11. No unnecessary splashing and water fights are allowed.
- 12. No splashing of guards or annoying them in any way that distract their attention from their work is allowed.
- 13. Homeowners are responsible for all guests and must accompany them. Maximum of 4 guests per family.
- 14. No floats or other large toys will be allowed when the pool is crowded.
- 15. No disposable diapers are allowed in the pool. (little swimmers are allowed)
- 16. No glass containers or alcoholic beverages are allowed in or around the pool.
- 17. Food is allowed only in the grassy areas or on the wooden deck.
- 18. Proper swimming attire must be worn at all times. No cut offs allowed.
- 19. No towels, sweatshirts, cut offs, etc. are allowed in the water; however tee shirts may be worn to protect against sunburn.
- 20. Persons with open wounds are not allowed in the pool.
- 21. No person having or apparently having an infectious disease, excess sunburn on his/hers body, plaster cast, adhesive, or bandage of any description shall be permitted in the pool.
- 22. All patrons should rinse off dirt, oils, and lotion before entering the pool.
- 23. DIVING
 - a. Only one person at a time is allowed on the diving board.
 - b. Divers are not to get on the diving ladders or board until the previous person has completed their dive.
 - c. Divers are not to execute their dive until the previous person has reached the wall or passed the buoy rope and then with only one bounce per dive.
 - d. Diving from the board must be straight off the end.
 - e. Diving is only permitted in water deeper than 6 feet.
 - f. No diving or swimming from the decks in the diving area unless the area has been closed by the lifeguard on duty.
 - g. To swim in the deep water, a person must be able to swim one width of the pool doing the front crawl without stopping.

 Any lifeguard upon request will administer the test.
- 24. No diving off guard chairs or use of them of any kind by the general public.
- 25. No sitting or pulling on the buoy rope separating the various areas.
- 26. No littering on the premises is allowed.
- 27. No smoking allowed by persons under the age of 18. Smokers are asked to use an ash can or throw all butts away after properly potting them out.
- 28. No pets allowed.
- 29. No one except lifeguards and Association Board members are permitted in the life guard room.
- 30. There is a 911 phone for emergencies only.
- 31. Bikes are to be chained to the bike rack right outside the pool
